Youth Program:

MOSS Program(BC Sailing)

At present the MOSS program has been running here 2 years, and we have applied for 1 week for next summer.

There is little or no follow up with the graduates of that course to encourage them to join the club, or to give them further instruction, partially, because we don't have the equipment to do so.

Sea Cadets:

White Sail program(CYA):

The ultimate goal is to buy 4-5 420s (16 ft dinghies) which could be used for youth and adult sailing camps.(Instructors would be available if we had the dinghies) The club would need to support this purchase which could amount to approximately \$10,000.00 for used boats. (These boats are frequently for sale, but snapped up quickly).
